

Novel approach to a Malaria Vaccine James Saba November 30, 2012

Herein is proposed an apparently novel means of vaccinating against malaria. Specifically it involves eliciting host antibodies to the mosquito's anticoagulant(s). This is anticipated to prevent the spread of, and perhaps infection by, the causative agent of malaria.

Further, it may be possible to immunize with the material of the inner wall of the mouth parts, particularly the labrum.
